In this issue of Jungle Book, we will give our readers a glimpse of activities by Nature Club Surat for the period of August to December 2018.

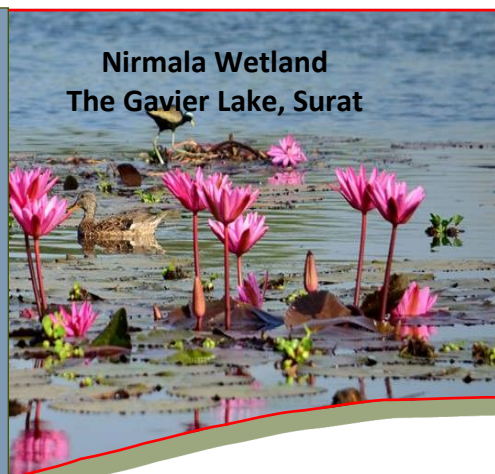
Upcoming activities during next six months by Nature Club Surat will give you an idea to come forward and take active part in these activities.
